NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority is the Canberra Yacht Club

1 RULES

- 1.1** The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021 - 2024* except for changes indicated in relevant paragraphs in this Notice of Race and in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2** The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) and the rules of each competing class will apply.
- 1.3** All races in the series are Category 7. The night race specified in 5.2 below will be Category 7 with additional inclusions of:
- All competitors must wear at all times during the night race a lifejacket complying with AS4758-2015 (minimum Level 50) or AS1512-1996 Type 1 or Type 2, or equivalent or more stringent overseas standard.
 - Navigation lights shall be carried that conform to the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (Part C and technical annex 1) and shall be exhibited as required by those regulations.
 - A personal location light to be carried by or attached to each member of the crew when on deck at night. A phone torch is not acceptable.
 - A working handheld or mounted VHF radio. SI will state what channel is to be monitored during the night race. The club will have limited handheld VHF's available for boats who do not have access to one.
- 1.4** RRS Part 4 preamble, 51, 52, 61.3, 62.1, 66, A5 will be changed as follows:
- RRS A5 is changed as detailed in paragraph 3.4, below.
 - RRS 61.3, 'Protest Time Limit', will be changed so that the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.
 - RRS 62.1 is changed as detailed in paragraph 3.5, below.
 - RRS 66, 'Reopening a Hearing', will be changed so that on the last day of the regatta a party to a hearing may ask for a reopening no later than 30 minutes after being informed of the decision on that day.
 - RRS A5, 'Scoring', will be changed so that any boat starting later than 10 minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS.
 - RRS 51 and 52 will be changed as follows:

A competitor may request permission from the Race Committee to use moveable and/or variable ballast for the purpose of increasing stability subject to a boat having been allocated a National yardstick / handicap rating. Stored power may be used for this operation. RRS 51 and 52 are modified to the extent required by this paragraph.

1.5 RRS Appendix T will apply. Arbitration may be used prior to a Protest Hearing.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising is permitted.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The series is open to all boats with an applicable AS Class Based Handicap (CBH) rating or a rating accepted or allocated by the CYC Sailing Committee.

3.2 Competitors may enter either online via the CYC website or by completing, signing, and lodging the entry form attached to this Notice of Race by the CoB 2nd December 2022. Late entries will be accepted up to 10:00am on 3rd December 2022 but will be subject to additional fees.

3.3 The person entering the boat and all crew must be current financial of AS in compliance with the AS prescription to RRS 46 applicable at the time of racing.

3.4 Registration and Sign-On shall be completed between 90 minutes and 30 minutes before the first warning signal of the scheduled starting sequence. Failure to Sign-On will result in a score of DNC for races on that day, unless Sign-On is completed before subsequent races on that day, in which case those subsequent races would be scored as sailed. This changes RRS A5.

3.5 A CBH rating allocated by the CYC Sailing Committee shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1.

4 FEES

4.1 The Regatta entry fees will be \$50.00 up to 5.00pm 2 December 2022. The entry fee for late entries (any submitted after that date) will be \$60.00.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 There will be a race briefing before the Night race on 2 December, held in the CYC Sailors Cabin at 1900 hours. There may be a regatta briefing in the CYC Sailor's Cabin at 1030 hours on Saturday 3rd December 2022.

5.2 Racing will be conducted in two Divisions:

Division 3 Boats with an AS or CYC SC allocated CBH of 0.7525 or greater

Division 4 Boats with an AS or CYC SC allocated CBH of less than 0.7525

5.3 The schedule of races for Divisions 3 and 4 will be as follows:

5.4 The Organising Authority may, where circumstances dictate, vary the format, classes and divisions and/or the schedule for the series.

6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1 Each boat, for which its class association or class rules requires it, shall have a valid measurement / rating certificate which is to be produced on demand to any race official or protest committee member.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available from 1200 hours on Friday 2nd December 2022 in the CYC office and thereafter on the CYC website at: www.canberrayc.com

8 SCORING

8.1 The Scoring System (RRS A4) will apply.

8.2 If 5 races are run each boat's series score shall be a total of her race scores excluding her worst score. If 4 or less races are run, a boat's series score shall be the total of all of her race scores.

8.3 The calculation of results for Divisions 3 and 4 will be based on the CBH ratings published by Australian Sailing as at 9 September 2022, or a CBH rating allocated by the CYC Sailing Committee.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10 PRIZES

10.1 The declaration of results and presentation of trophies will take place at the CYC Sailors' Cabin following completion of the CYC Club Racing (Pointscore 11 Championship 6) on Sunday 4 December 2022.

10.2 Prizes will be awarded to the following:

(a) 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each Division, and

(b) additional prizes may also be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or the equivalent.
