Notice of Race

RULES

1. As notified in the CYC POINTSCORE and CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES 2017-2018 Notice of Race.

ADVERTISING

2. Advertising is permitted.

ELIGIBILITY

3. As notified in the CYC POINTSCORE and CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES 2017-2018 Notice of Race.

FEES

4. As notified in the CYC POINTSCORE and CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES 2017-2018 Notice of Race.

ENTRY

5. As notified in the CYC POINTSCORE and CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES 2017-2018 Notice of Race.

SCHEDULE OF RACES

6. The schedule of races is contained in the CYC Sailing Program 2017-2018 and the warning signal for the first Division shall be 1400 hours. There will be two races per day for the following Divisions:

Division 1	International Flying Fifteens
Division 2	Sportsboats
Division 3	Trailable yachts / Trailable multihulls
Division 4	Off the beach multihulls with VYC yardstick 83.5 and below
Division 5	Off the beach multihulls with VYC yardstick above 84
Division 6	Lasers (all variants)
Division 7	Dinghies (excluding Lasers, Contenders and Optimists)
Division 8	Contenders
Division 9	Optimist dinghies.

The start of the second race each day for Divisions will follow closely after the conclusion of the first race and may not be in Division sequence.

MEASUREMENTS

7. Each boat shall comply with Class Rules and / or have a valid measurement / rating certificate which is to be produced on demand by any race official or protest committee member.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8. The Sailing Instructions will be available from 1000 hours on 24 September 2017 at CYC.

COURSES

9. The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

SCORING

10.1 As notified in the CYC POINTSCORE and CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES 2016-2017 NOR this Series will be scored as part of the POINTSCORE SERIES.

10.2. A boat that DNC, did not start, did not finish, retired or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place based on the number of boats entered in the race plus 1. This changes RRS A4.2.

10.3. Skippers who are rostered for race management duty will be given average points for their boat for that race as calculated by TopYacht Software. This supplements RRS 62.1.

RADIO COMMUNICATION

11. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

PRIZES

12. Prizes and trophies will be awarded in accordance with CYC policies and procedures.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

INSURANCE

14. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event or the equivalent.
